WHAT:

A monthly meeting to give providers the opportunity to meet each other, learn about community resources, and discuss community needs.



HISTORY:

The Interagency Meeting was established in May of 2021 as part of an effort to establish a System of Care. Social Service providers identified a need to connect with other providers in order to learn more about what services are available and to build working relationships. Watertown providers noticed a lack of awareness of the numerous agencies/ services in the area and our organizations are committed to working to improve services and awareness for clients.

Meetings are held the 2nd Thursday of the month at 9am with this quarterly rotation

Month 1 (Starting June 2024): In person at the Police Department Community Room (1 ½ hours) - Networking with providers, discussing community needs, and sharing generalized scenarios about how to help clients (September, December, March, June)

Month 2 (Starting July 2024): Zoom meeting (1 hour) - A speaker to present on a community topic of interest. (October, January, April, July)

Month 3 (Starting August 2024): In person (1 hour) - Site visit to different social service providers. This provider will lead the meeting. (November, February, May, August)
